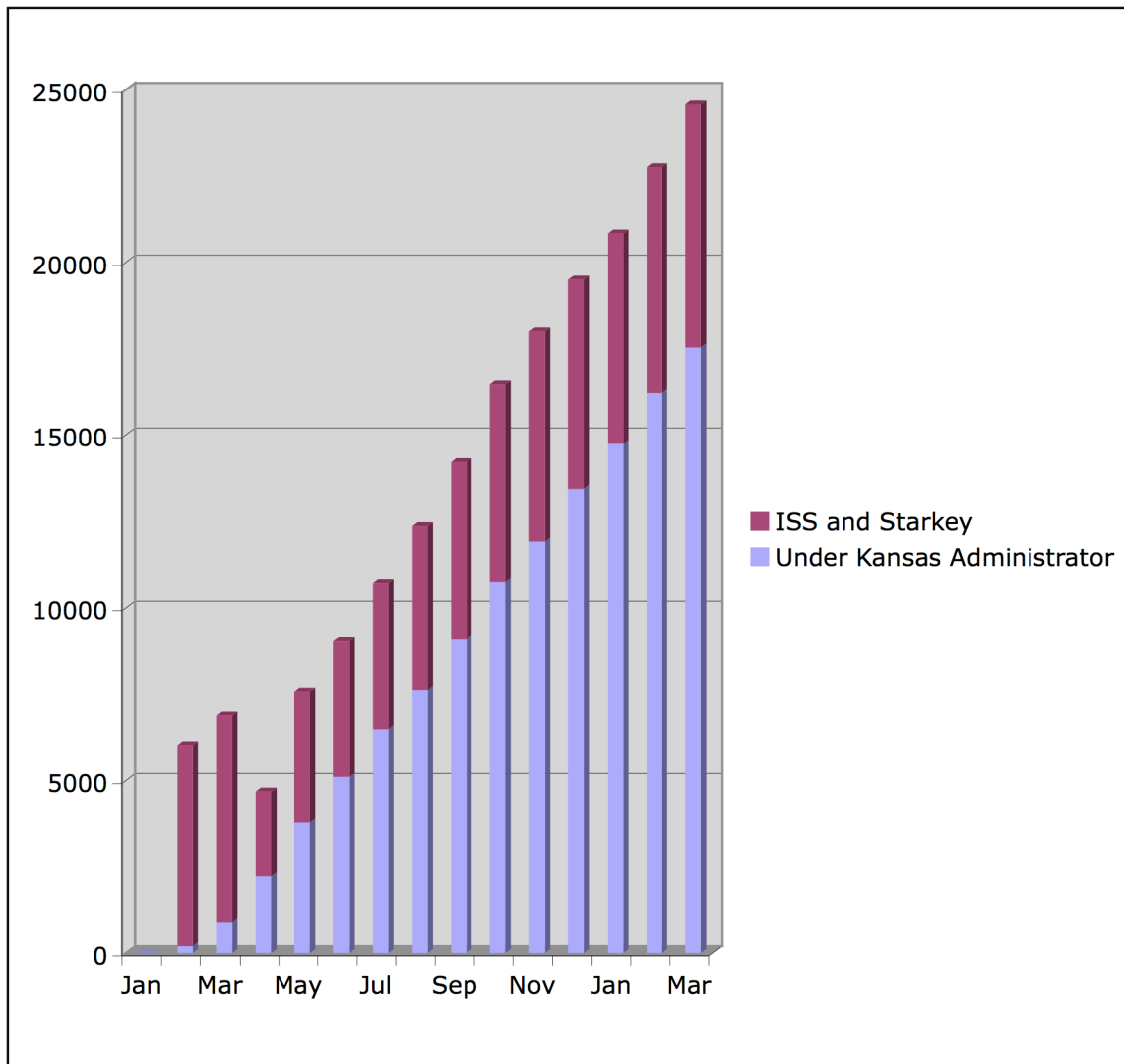
Activities

- The College of Direct Support in Kansas continues to expand. Providers are finding new uses for CDS, building career ladders, and linking completion to salary increases.
- Foster parents are using more courses for training. The Medication Administration Course has been used more frequently.
- The Ad Astra Apprenticeship committee met twice in February, once to explore career ladder options and once to review apprentice portfolios.
- The quarterly Kansans Mobilizing for Workforce Change Advisory meeting was held in Topeka. Agenda has been sent under separate cover. Planning has begun for workshops for supervisors and CDS administrators.
- Technical assistance continues. A focus this month has been on introducing the

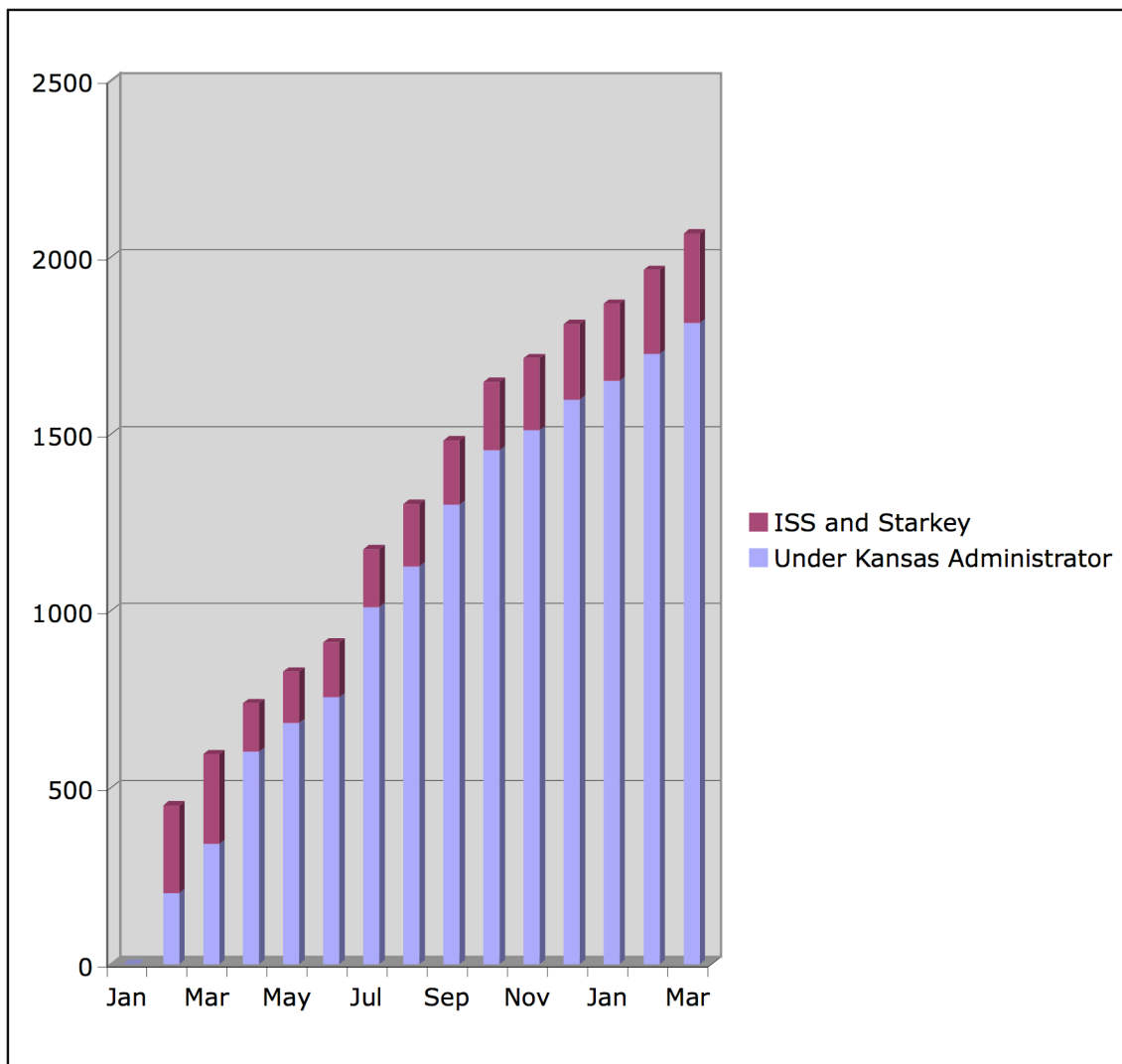
randomized test bank to administrators and using the option to limit access to the post-test until lessons have been completed.

- A CDS Partner Profile has been added to the National CDS Website highlighting the use of CDS at Individual Support Systems. This is the second Kansas profile.
- The apprenticeship program will be highlighted at the National Symposium on Strengthening the HCBS Direct Service Workforce sponsored by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the U.S. Department of Labor. held in Baltimore, Maryland May 8-9, 2008
- A presentation on Marketing to DSPs will be made at the InterHab Workforce Summit this summer.
